'Yet you balanced an eel on the end of your nose- what made you so awfully clever?'




As a duck with its eyelids, so he with his nose Trims his belt and his buttons, and turns out his toes. $\pounds 250$



'Curiouser and curiouser!' cried Alice £350






The Hatter hurriedly left the court, without even waiting to put his shoes on $$\pm 650$$

Yet you finished the goose, with the bones and the beak - Pray, how did you manage to do it? $\pounds 250$



And he grinned almost from ear to ear, as he leant forwards...and offered Alice his hand. $\pounds 550$




He had a tall red night-cap on, with a tassel, and he was lying crumpled up into a sort of untidy heap, and snoring loud...







he was far too much astonished to cry out, but his eyes and his mouth want on getting larger and larger...







I knew it was!' cried Tweedledum, beginning to stamp about wildly and tear his hair $\pounds 300$




I said it very loud and clear; I went and shouted in his ear. $\mbox{\ensuremath{\pounds}250}$

Its body is made of plum-pudding, its wings of holly-leaves, and its head is a raisin burning in brandy' $\pounds 250$




Its wings are thin slices of bread-and-butter, its body is a crust, and its head is a lump of sugar' £250




Look up, speak nicely, and don't twiddle your fingers all the time $\pounds 550$

one good pull, and plates, dishes, guests, and candles came crashing down together in a heap on the floor.




she didn't feel a bit surprised at finding the Red Queen and the White Queen sitting close to her... $\pounds 450$

Snowdrop, my pet!' she went on, looking over her shoulder at the White Kitten $$\pm 400$$




So they walked on together through the wood... $% \label{eq:controller}$




Ten minutes allowed for refreshments!' $\pounds 550$



The chessmen were walking about, two and two! $\pounds 300 \label{eq:energy}$




the ground was soon covered with little heaps of men $\pounds 250$




the Guard was looking at her, first through a telescope then through a microscope, and then through an opera-glass




the kitten had been having a grand game of romps with the ball of worsted Alice had been trying to wind up \dots



The leg of mutton got up in the dish and made a little bow to Alice... $\label{eq:e250} \texttt{£250}$




The White Knight is sliding down the poker. He balances very badly $\pounds 250$
